

Procedure for enlistment:

TEDA will

1. accept the receipt of applications towards enlistment for SWHS and SPV systems only during the first fifteen days of the months of April, July, October and January.
2. issue enlistment letters to the vendors in the next fifteen days of the respective months with 3 year validity from the date of issue of enlistment letter.
3. Security Deposit of Rs. 50,000/- irrespective of category as DD will be collected at the first instance and then to enhance the same when required towards enlistment as follows since the verification of genuineness and follow up of Bank Guarantee is very difficult and also the CFA released to the Vendors is very high.

Mandatory Training:

- Vendors who apply to TEDA for enlistment should enclose a valid training certificate issued to their technicians by a recognized government training institutes/centres like MSME , NSIC , TEDA etc., for the training undergone by them in respect of installation and commissioning of Solar thermal systems/Solar PV systems or both as per applicability.
- Vendors who have already enlisted with TEDA should ensure that the technicians working under them undergo the training if they have not undergone any training in respect of installation and commissioning of Solar thermal systems/ Solar PV systems or both as per applicability and furnish the certificate issued by the recognized government training institutes/centres to TEDA within 3 months from the date of receipt of Enlistment .Failing which the enlistment certificate issued to them will be treated as invalid
